REPORT FOR THURSDAY 7TH MARCH

482 Prime Hoggs

Another belting trade for all meat hoggs, lesser quality hoggs were hard sold but to a strong trade nevertheless. SQQ 350.60p/kg. All weights were in demand with no ceiling on the heavy hoggs. AJ Cony & Partners topped the day overall with a sterling show of Suffolk hoggs at 56kgs selling to £197. RC & JT Bailey topped pence per kilo with a show of best meat Texels at 377p/kg for 52kgs.

Highlights - JI Holmes saw a strong trade for Continental hoggs at 45kgs selling to £167.50 with 64.5kgs to £193; Guilford & Sons penned another top run of Texels seeing 45kgs to £165; Corney & Sons penned their usual stamp of Charollais seeing a high at £181 for 49kgs; RC & JT Bailey topped with their Texel crosses to £196.50 for 59kgs.

Raveley Fen Farms topped the day with a best end showing of Charollais ewes to £160.50; Little Oxendon Farms saw the best of the Suffolk trade with thick heavy ewes to £149 and £148 with lean meat types at £139.50, also topping the Mules for the day with big framed heavy ewes to £116; Corney & Sons saw compact meat Charollais to £143. All well bred meat ewes were £110 plus with true feeders in the £80's.

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 9TH MARCH

Store & Breeding Cattle

A great entry of empty feeding cows came forward today, which sold to £2000 for a 45 month Simmental from J Millbank with her others selling to £1400, £1360 and £1270 from £430; TN Thomson sold a 131 month Angus cow to £570; A Bartlett sold a Blue cow with a Hereford heifer calf at foot to £860, empty cows to £710 from £550 and a Hereford bull to £1020; Messrs Aves sold their empty cows to £1270 from £630.

Store Cattle – A good start to the day with H Houghton & Son selling Blue steers 26 months to £1520, a heifer to £1420 and Angus steers to £1500; TN Thomson sold 10 month Angus steers to £990 from £900; S Bowles entered a Dexter steer which sold to £240 and heifers to £165; R Wood & Son entered thirty Hereford steers and heifers which sold to £1020 for the steers and heifers sold to £860; WBK Smith & Son sold yearling Simmental heifers to £1180 from £1080; R Law sold twenty-three Saler heifers to £1220 for a 21 month old and 9-10 month heifers to £880 from £735; SGC Hill sold yearling Charolais steers to £1160, Saler steers to £1120 and heifers to £1110; K Hall entered nine Limousin steers 7-12 months which sold to £1000 from £900; JA & P Dickinson sold 23 month Limousin heifers to £1460 from £1400; J Kendall sold Continental heifers to £1210 from £1020; J Bottesch sold three Limousin heifers to £1830 from £1480; RL Root & Son sold Angus steers to £1000 for a 15 month from £760 for a 9 month and his heifers sold to £800 for 11 months; RA Ford entered eighteen South Devon steers which sold to £1135 from £870 and Angus steers 9-11 months to £1170 from £900; Fineseasons sold yearling Angus steers to £950 and a Blue to £900; J & D Bavington sold Limousin heifers to £1190 and Simmental heifers to £1080.

Store & Breeding Sheep

Store Lambs - another fantastic trade off the back of the prime market, with prices far exceeding lean lambs sold in the prime. All in average £106.34. R & M Arrowsmith topped the day with a sterling show of Texel ewe lambs topping to £172 with Suffolks at £160; B Currie saw a smart run of Texel Mules seeing the biggest frame at £130 and followers to £120; NS Seamark & Son topped their Suffolks at £126, leading on to £119, and £105; S Tunnicliffe topped with smart bred Texel lambs at £124 with the smaller frames to £106 and big framed Mule crosses to £115; CJ Harris drew Charollais crosses in forward condition but smaller framed selling to £115.50. Longest term chancy lambs were seen at £63 and £44.

Cade Lambs - another strong trade this week with RA Bounds selling Continentals to £22 and £20; RF Davy saw £21 for month old lambs; RD Holland sold Texels at a week old for £10.

Feeding Ewes & Rams - a strong trade with limited numbers, averaging £79.44. RD Holland topped to £110 for Texels, with Mules to £70; S Tunnicliffe topped the rams with Texels to £109.50; A Harrod saw Romney's to £70.

Ewes & Lambs - off the clock trade with strong lambs flying. All in average saw £91.99 per life. T Hinch penned a well grown run of ewes and 3 week old lambs topping the day with 6 tooth Suffolk ewes with single Texels lambs to £125 a life or £250 the outfit, with their doubles selling to £110 a life of £330 an outfit, full mouth Continental ewes with single lambs topped at £120 a life; P & KF Chapman saw a smart show of Charollais ewes with Dutch Spotted lambs selling to £82 a life for doubles and £80 a life or £320 for triplets; A Harrod's full and broken mouthed Romney ewes with week old Texels lambs sold to £65 a life for singles or £60 a life for the doubles.


