Prime Hoggs

Trade continues on the same level path, although today saw better quality forward on the whole. SQQ380.48p/kg. J & M Ironmonger topped the day pence per kilo with a sterling show of Charollais and Texel hoggs seeing a high of 406p/kg for 43.5kgs with their 43kg and 45kgs Texels at 388p/kg and 50kgs to 375p/kg. B Rawlinson saw a quality show of Continental hoggs at 45kgs also selling to 406p/kg. DM Harris topped the day overall with Bleu du Maine hoggs at 56kgs selling to £211.68.
