Trade holds on the week with meat and conformation performing best on the day. SQQ 261.93p/kg. DM & A Andrews topped the day with 271p/kg and £135.50 for best shape and meat Blue Texel hogs at 50kgs.

Highlights - Hadley Farms Ltd topped with a smart showing of Continental hogs at 270p/kg for 40.5kgs with 38.5kgs selling to the same level; JD Weaver had a smart trade for Charollais crosses with 41kg topping to 260p/kg and 258p/kg for 43.5kgs; Clark Farms topped the heavier lambs with Charollais crosses at 50.5kgs to 266p/kg.

WJ Barnett & Son topped with a big framed entry of Suffolk lambs at £88; Kineton Lamb drew a smart run of uniform Lleyn cross Texels seeing £80 for twenty and £77.50 for twenty-four; N & LC Holdsworth saw their Texels to £73; WB Parker saw their biggest frame Charollais crosses to £69. Longest term lambs were seen around the £40 mark.
