Update on Capital Grants

DEFRA have announced that they have secured funding to re-open the Capital Grant Scheme for 2025/26.

The RPA will begin to process 4,040 completed Capital Grant applications that were put on hold in November 2024. If you have previously submitted an application, it will automatically be processed and if approved you will receive an agreement.

The scheme will re-open later this year for anyone who would like to submit a new Capital Grant Application.

Limits will be set on how much you can apply for in each of the 4 categories available. The new limits will be:

- £25,000 for water quality
- £25,000 for air quality
- £25,000 natural flood management
- £35,000 for boundaries, trees and orchards

You can apply for a grant in more than one category but only one application per Single Business Identifier (SBI) can be submitted per year.

If you submitted an application and it was put on hold, the new caps will not apply to you. The RPA will honour the offer as it was when you applied.



Hedgerow Management Rules

The no cutting period for hedgerows on or next to land used for agriculture, starts on the 1st March, and lasts until the 31st August.

Cutting or trimming is only permitted from 1st March to 31st August in the following situations:

- The hedgerow overhangs a highway, road or footpath over which there is a public or private right of way
- To carry out hedge-laying or coppicing, or to trim a newly laid hedgerow by hand, within 6 months of it being laid.
- The hedgerow is within the curtilage of a dwelling house, or the hedgerow marks the boundary of the curtilage of a dwelling house
- You need to prevent or treat serious causes of harm to plant health, there is a risk to human or animal health or safety, or you need to prevent or treat a serious pest or weed infestation

You will also need to notify the RPA each year before you cut or trim a hedgerow in August to sow oilseed rape or temporary grass.
