Prime Hoggs

Prices lift again for quality hoggs with meat commanding the trade and heavies seeing the biggest lift. SQQ 296.03p/kg. AJ Webster topped the day with a sterling show of Beltex hoggs at 43kgs selling to 351p/kg. WR Haines topped the day overall with thick Charollais crosses to £168.21 for 63kgs with 58.5kg Suffolks to £164.39 and £156.34 for 53kgs.

Highlights - Clark Farms penned a smart show of best meat Texel hoggs at 45kgs selling to 308p/kg, with their 46.5kgs to 300p/kg; B Hemmings topped the lightest hoggs with Texel crosses at 35kgs selling to 290p/kg; H Taylor penned a smart run of Lleyns with good meat reaching 301p/kg for 41.5kgs, with 41kgs to 298p/kg and 39.5kgs to 293.5p/kg; Dancer Brothers penned a nice meat showing of fed Charollais crosses at 39.5kgs topping to 300p/kg, with 48kgs of better shape reaching the same mark; A Berks topped with some well fed Texel hoggs to 56kgs at 295p/kg with their Suffolks at 53kgs reaching 289p/kg.

THE UK GOVERNMENT'S NEW EMERGENCY ALERTS SYSTEM IS NOW LIVE

The system will enable people to be contacted via their mobile phone when lives are in danger. On Sunday 23 April 2023 at 3pm, there will be a national test of the Emergency Alerts service.

It will be used to warn you in the event of emergencies, such as severe flooding. Emergency Alerts are sent to all compatible mobile phones within an area of risk. They don't track your location, need your phone number, or collect personal data. Only the government and the emergency services will be able to send them. If you don't have a mobile phone, you'll still be kept informed through other channels.

If you get an Emergency Alert on your phone, you'll hear a loud, siren-like sound. A message on your screen will tell you about the emergency and how best to respond. You'll be able to check an alert is genuine at gov.uk/alerts

If you receive an alert, read the alert carefully and follow the instructions.

You can opt out of receiving emergency alerts; for more information on how to opt out please go to gov.uk/alerts


