REPORT FOR THURSDAY 23RD FEBRUARY

277 Prime Hoggs

Lighter export hoggs see a massive lift on the week, with a better than predicted trade throughout. SQQ 228.42p/kg. BJ Reynolds topped the day with 256p/kg for their Beltex hoggs at 32kgs. ME Darby topped the day overall with Charollais crosses selling to £115 for 53kgs.

Highlights - BJ Reynolds saw more highs with 38kgs Texel crosses selling to £89; K Mallinder saw the same price for smart Texel hoggs at 37.5kg and 35kgs; M Turner drew the usual quality of goods with 44.5kg Texel and Beltex crosses selling to £106 with 42kgs at £104; C Stancombe & Son saw comparable highs with Texel Mules to £102 for 45.5kgs. Heavier hoggs saw similar levels to previous weeks with R & M Arrowsmith topping to £110 for 50kgs.

FARMING EQUIPMENT & TECHNOLOGY FUND

New round of Farming Equipment and Technology Fund (FETF):

With DEFRA currently producing new information on the rollout of new and existing grants available to farmers and landowners, we have now had information on the Farming Equipment and Technology Fund as part of the Investment Fund available in England for farmers, foresters, and growers.

Grants are available between £1,000 and £25,000 for equipment that assist in improving land's productivity, sustainability and to improve animal health and welfare on farm. The new round of grants for Productivity and Slurry items under FETF will open towards the end of February, while Animal Health and Welfare items will open in March, following on from a successful first round in Late 2021.

Annexe 3 and 4 outline eligible items of equipment that are available, with a few examples including:

- Direct Drill with Fertiliser Placement 3m this would contribute up to £25,000 based on an estimated cost of £68,000.
- Robotic Silage Pusher this would contribute up to £5,800 based on an estimated cost of £14,500.
- Heat and Service Detector contribute up to £438 based on an estimated cost of £1,095.
- Badger Proof Lick Holders contribute up to £68 based on an estimated cost of £170 per holder.

Funding will be allocated on a score assigned basis in relation to how well the applicant meets the scheme's objectives. As part of the second rollout, the list of items available within the grant has been significantly multiplied, including 66 more items to support animal health and welfare, as well as 19 to aid productivity and 2 items to support slurry management.

DEFRA strongly advise that, should applicants have not been successful in receiving funding in the first round of applications, they should not be deterred in applying again for this second instalment. Each item is given a clear grant value, and following a successful application, the item can then be bought, with the grant money being paid after the item is received and installed (where applicable). It is encouraging that the second rollout of FETF has been issued, and we look forward to providing further guidance on the future of ELMS as we transition away from direct payments. Store lambs - a more even trade for the lambs forward, a longer term showing with the majority of big and small frames needing a lot of further finishing. All in average £63.85. M Holben topped the day with Blue Texel rams to £100, with Texel crosses at £96; DM Cutmore & Son drew a well finished run of Continental crosses to £91.50, with Texel crosses at £89.50; TR Dean saw a big run of long term Suffolk and Charollais crosses topping to £80.50; WG Childs & Sons continue to draw their usual stamp with smarter Continental crosses to £80. A large proportion in the £70's this week with the smallest in the £60's and £50's.

Feeding ewes - extreme ends of the spectrum forward this week, with ewes averaging £63.85. Prices ranged from £18 to £110 from RJ Garley for their Texels; with TR Dean topping to £102 for similar types; Webb Hatherley Livestock topped the Mules at £88. Prices remain the same week on week, with the stamp of ewes fluctuating the averages.

Breeding sheep - Webb Hatherley Livestock saw another quality draw of full mouth North Country Mule ewes, scanned with twins topping at £132 over three pens; RJ Garley saw the trade of the day with their ewes and lambs at foot, seeing double theave Suffolks top at £276 or £92 a life, with full mouth Suffolk / Scotch selling to £246 or £82 a life.


