Finished, Store & Breeding Cattle

Fat Cattle - Two forward this week from EF Wootton & Son, selling to £2106 or 272p.

Cull Cows - Two forward this week from NP & MJ Russell sold to £980 for a 10 year old Angus cow and £900 for a 13 year old Simmental.

Cows & Calves - A 36 month Aberdeen Angus heifer with a 6 week old Lincoln Red bull calf at foot sold to £980.

Store Cattle - MF Longfoot & Son sold four 18 month Herefords at £900 and decided to take home their 16-18 month Angus steers at a bit over £900; GC James & Co sold a 13 month Lincoln Red heifer to £550; C & R Farming sold 33-36 month Hereford steers to £1220, a 33 month to £780, 24 months to £660, 6-7 months to £575 and 9-10 month heifers to £370; J Kimbell sold 20-22 month Saler and Limousin heifers to £1190, 12 month Charolais heifers to £930 and 18-20 month Angus heifers to £790; CJ White sold 12-13 month Charolais steers to £1525 and heifers to £1200; BC & MB King sold 11 month Blonde heifers to £1140 and 8 month Simmental heifers to £960; A & I Fraser Ltd sold 10-11 month Charolais steers to £1060 and heifers 5-10 months to £900; WJ Warner sold a 23 month Limousin steer to £1585 and 23 month Angus steers to £1350; EM Sherwin & Son sold 25 month Hereford steers to £1550 and heifers to £880; Corney & Sons Ltd sold 11-15 month Limousin steers to £1540; J & D Bavington sold 24 month Longhorn steers to £830 and a heifer to £800.

A 4 week old Aberdeen Angus bull from Hyde Lane Farms sold to £250.

Store & Breeding Sheep

Store Lambs - A continuation of last week's rise, with trade flying up again. All in average £78.71, fantastic trade for the lambs forward. J Grace topped to £128 for best end Texel Beltex hoggs; R Martin saw equal highs for smart Texels topping to £109; L Brawn had a smart showing of Hampshires forward with rams selling to £105 and others at £96; W Aves & Son penned longer term lambs with the brightest reaching £93. The smallest long term were seen around £60, looking dearer on the week.

Cade Lambs - The best trade to date with FC Lester & Son topping to £26 for Suffolk lambs; CA Stubbs topped their Roussins at £25; and A Lund saw £24 for her Texels.

Feeding Ewes - A smart showing of meat forward averaging £76.96. J & S Livestock topped the day at £212 for Dutch Spotted ewes; NP & MJ Russell topped their entry with Charollais ewes to £114 with smaller types at £96.50 and £95; J Grace topped their Suffolks to £100 with Continentals at £95, their Mules topped the day at £85.50. Smaller frame ewes saw low £70's, with true feeding types in the £40's.

Breeding Sheep - P & KF Chapman topped the breeders with a Dutch Spotted 2 shear ram selling to £225, from the same home Suffolk x Herdwick double theaves with singles sold to £94 a life with the doubles selling to £282 an outfit; Heleben Settlement saw £79 a life or £237 an outfit with their Texel double theaves with twin lambs. **more ewes and lambs are booked in for next week**


