A fantastic lift in trade with hoggs rocketing in demand through all weights after the Easter shortage. Markets continue to thrive, far outperforming deadweight comparisons!! F & SM Stamper topped the day with Beltex hoggs to 374p/kg for 38kgs. Corney & Sons topped the day overall with monstrous Charollais to £161 for 65.5kgs. SQQ 308.26p/kg.

Highlights - F & SM Stamper topped with 38kgs to £142, their heavier entries saw 44kgs to £153 and 39.5kgs to £143; B Currie topped their showing with Texel crosses at £136 for 45kgs; with TJ Collins & Sons seeing £134 for their Charollais at 44.5kgs; H Steels penned a smart run of Continentals at 44kgs selling to £133; R & S Anderson had a sterling run of best finished Continental hoggs seeing their lightest at 49.5kgs top to £157, with 50kgs to £155; DB Standing had another smart show of best end Charollais forward selling to £156 for 52kgs; Corney & Sons topped overall prices for the day with 65.5kgs to £161 with 57kgs at £157.

TJ Collins & Sons flew to the top with best meat Charollais ewes reaching £187, with followers to £179 and £165; RA Ford topped the Suffolks on the day with powerful ewes to £182; F & SM Stamper topped the smartest types with best shape Beltex crosses to £180; RD Holland saw the trade of the day with Mule ewes to £159. The vast majority of ewes forward were above £135. Leaner meat ewes continue to trade at their own rate but weight and meat consistently top all demands.

THE UK GOVERNMENT'S NEW EMERGENCY ALERTS SYSTEM IS NOW LIVE

The system will enable people to be contacted via their mobile phone when lives are in danger. On Sunday 23 April 2023 at 3pm, there will be a national test of the Emergency Alerts service.

It will be used to warn you in the event of emergencies, such as severe flooding. Emergency Alerts are sent to all compatible mobile phones within an area of risk. They don't track your location, need your phone number, or collect personal data. Only the government and the emergency services will be able to send them. If you don't have a mobile phone, you'll still be kept informed through other channels.

If you get an Emergency Alert on your phone, you'll hear a loud, siren-like sound. A message on your screen will tell you about the emergency and how best to respond. You'll be able to check an alert is genuine at **gov.uk/alerts**

If you receive an alert, read the alert carefully and follow the instructions.

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 15TH APRIL

Finished, Store & Breeding Cattle

Breeding Cattle - A continuation of EG Dodson & Son with their herd dispersal saw a top end trade for both cows & calves and the trade stronger on the week. Outfits topped to £1510 for Angus cows with registered Angus bull calves at foot, Simmental crosses of the same stamp flew to £1400 with British Blue and Angus heifer calves to £1370.

Store Cattle - Following on with the stores; trade booms again with highs of £1620 from W Darby & Sons with their best end Limousin steers, following entries of the same stamp were at £1570; RD Holland penned a tremendous show of Limousin steers selling to £1500; KS Lee had their first consignment of Charollais through the market this week with smart matching runs of steers at 13 months old topping to £1290 and £1210 for the heifers; GT Frossell & Son penned at well grown run of Angus steers at 15 months reaching £1250; SJ &RE Helliwell topped their well bred Limousin steers at 12 months old to £1040.

Calves

RJ Lee saw their Angus heifer calves to £20.

406 Store & Breeding Sheep

Store Lambs - A fantastic draw of quality from the top drawer this week, with longest term lambs following the highs of the trade. All in average saw £100.25. W Hammond topped the day with best end Beltex ram lambs flying to £146, with their Texel crosses to £135; J Breare & J Brooks saw equal highs with their Dorsets flying to £145; R Spendlove saw some of the best trade of the day with Texel crosses to £135; Paybody Farms topped with their Romneys to £129 for lambs in forward condition; Vanish Point Farm saw highs of £117 for Suffolks with frame; P Clarke topped at £117 for Continentals showing promise and in forward condition. The vast majority of entries were over £90, following the hike in the prime hogg trade with only the very longest term, island types in the £50's.

Cade Lambs - Record entry forward, forty-six on the day seeing M Towler topping to £25 for Lleyn lambs; RJ Paybody & Sons had their Texel crosses to £24; with R Jackson reaching £15. All in average £12.74.

Feeding Ewes - What a day, what a show! Trade off the clock with best end Blue Texel ewes from J Breare & J Brooks topping to £227 with their mates at £185; M Kellet had a smart showing of Texels with big frame ewes reaching £159; NS Seamark topped to £156 for their meat Suffolks; RJ Paybody & Sons saw the best trade with Mule ewes to £124; D King topped with Charollais at £122 for shape and meat. All meat is in demand, lean or heavy. True feeding types were seen sub £60, with ancient Hebrideans still selling to £38.

Breeding Sheep - A show style entry of ewe lambs forward with a ewe lamb dispersal from J Barnett seeing Beltex lambs to £208 and Texel cross Beltex to £205. Charollais crosses peaked at £172 with Texels to £164, Scotch Half Breds saw just as strong trade selling to £142; M Kellet topped with Texel ewe lambs to £155. All in average for ewe lambs £165.

Ewes with Lambs - Trade transforms in a week with full confidence in the grass growth showing. JD & JA Miles topped the day with full mouth Continental ewes and single lambs selling to £91 a life, with their full mouth Mule ewes and twin lambs peaking at £81 a life or £243 the outfit; I Birden penned a sterling show of Cheviot theaves and Dutch Spotted lambs realising £86 a life or £258 the outfit, with their full mouth ewes looking a picture and selling to £82 a life; CD Hughes saw a smart show of Cheviot crosses top at £85 a life with their 6 tooth Scotch Mules to £68 with younger twin lambs; DR Harrod drew a smart run of Shropshire ewes and lambs seeing the strongest to £75 a life; D Player penned full mouth/ broken mouth Mules with single Texel lambs selling to £70 a life. All in average over the ewes and lambs £60.53.
