446 Prime Lambs

Trade looks to have bounced back with the trade strong for meat in the alleys this week. The SQQ doesn't reflect the trade at 291.24p/kg. Raveley Fen Farms topped the day pence per kilo at 330p/kg for best end Beltex lambs at 45.5kgs. Cartwright Farms topped the day overall at £165 for 57kgs Charollais.

Highlights - F Southall & Son saw the best of the lightweight lambs with 38.5kgs Texels to £116.50; George Thompson Farms saw their usual best end Continentals see the same market highs with 44kgs to 330p/kg or £145 with 45kgs at £145 and £142.50; P & KF Chapman topped with their Dutch Spotted lambs at 324p/kg with 47.5kgs to £154; HD & PJ Cranfield saw their Texel crosses to £160 for 60kgs with 50kgs to £154, their same stamp of Continentals topped at £146 for 48.5kgs.

Trade remains the same with only the quality of the ewes affecting the averages. Averaging £104.49. CA & AB Watson topped the day with best end Charollais ewes to £168 with big framed lean rams to £111; JI & JA Claypole topping with their Suffolk cross ewes to £156; S Goodship saw smart Charollais to £152 for mid frame ewes; S Bailey topped their Suffolks at £149 with Texel crosses to £126; Cambridge University Farm saw the best of the Mule trade with big framed meat to £116. As usual all lean meat sold better than the fat. True feeders were seen at £70 plus, with meat ewes £100 plus.

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 13TH JULY

Store & Breeding Cattle

Cows & Calves sold to £1120 for a 7 year old Red Poll cow with a 2 month Lincoln Red heifer calf at foot from PR Rogers.

Prices topped at £1370 for a Hereford steer from RL, GL & JF Pierce with their Angus steers selling to £1285 and heifers to £1240; SL Fletcher sold his entry to £1240 for a 30 month Lincoln Red steer and heifers to £940 for a 27 month British Blue, his Angus heifers sold to £760 from £555 and three Lincoln Red heifers that had run with the bull sold to £1205

Calves

Only four in today from FH Pullin & Sons sold to £80 for 4 week old Holstein Friesian bulls (More in this week).

Pigs

An entry of fifty weaned pigs today sold to £46 for pigs from T Bately with others to £32 and R Daubney sold Saddleback pigs to £28 from £24.

Store & Breeding Sheep

Store Lambs - a smart trade for a majority showing of cade lamb stores, all in average £78.42. C Smith topped the day with a smart show of Texels topping to £142 with the ram lamb equivalent at £138; AC Downing saw part meat Texel crosses to £122; S Garley saw the trade of the day with Continental cades in forward condition selling to £118, £107 and £92; Rook Bros saw their young lambs to £79 with followers at £68 for ram lambs. Indoor reared cades a long way off sold to £41 and £38 for rams.

Store Hoggs - a good showing of quality, averaging £101.27. S Gawthroup topped to £142 for several pens of Charollais ewe lambs with Texels crosses at £134; J Pringle saw big framed Texel hoggs at £133; D Jerrams penned a respectable show of native cross hoggs selling to £90.

Feeding Ewes - one of the best shows of ewes in recent times, averaging £102.94. J Pringle topped to £191 for best meat Texel ewes, seeing Charollais crosses to £182; C Leeson topped the Suffolk ewes with thick to £152, seeing leaner meat Lleyn crosses to £100; AC Downing penned Scotch Half Bred meat ewes to £142 with the trade of the day at £122 and £96 for lean meat Mules. True native bred feeders were seen in the £50's.


