**Highlights** - R Swinfen & Sons saw more of the same with 38.5kg Texels flying to £138; Cambridge University Farm topped their best end Texel Mules with 45kgs at £150, with their Suffolks of equal power at 44kgs selling to £147; W Hammond saw a flyer with tremendous Texels at 42kgs selling to £148 for two pens.

A good entry of **Cows & Calves** this week. 
