244 Prime Lambs

Quality lambs make the trade for anything over 42kgs and export quality, with leaner big framed lambs selling, but a harder trade. SQQ 248.67p/kg. J & M Ironmonger topped the day at 260p/kg for best meat 48kg Charollais, also topping the day overall at £124.80.

Highlights - Saffron Estates penned another quality showing of Charollais with 46kg meat lambs selling to 258p/kg; T Young had their first full draw of Charollais with best meat lambs at 42kgs selling at 257p/kg with their 48kgs of the same stamp reaching 252p/kg; Gipsy Hall Farms topped with well finished Easycare Charollais at 41kgs to 254p/kg; R Hall & Sons saw a well finished run of Texel Mules to 251p/kg for 45kgs with their Suffolks of the same stamp at 47kgs selling to 250p/kg.

All meat and good framed ewes were £90 plus with feeding types at £70 plus. More are needed to meet demand.
