#### Elmdene Farm, Hitchin, Hertfordshire – Friday 12th May 2023

A great crowd gathered at the sale, a shower of rain dampened the atmosphere for a while, but fierce bidding still battled away through the rain drops with 430 lots going under the hammer, getting off to a great start with the pile of scrap metal at £520 and a little later a pile of old corrugated tin roof sheets sold to £610. Some interesting vintage items including two wireless boxed army phones, vintage garden tools, galvanised troughs, poultry equipment and garden sundries along with the usual tool shed goodies that had been hidden away for years. Along with the small items the Vehicles, Tractors and Machinery saw very high demand for all that was presented in the sale with the JCB realising £48,100, the New Holland 8340 tractor selling to an incredible £28,200, The McCormick tractors sold to £26,500 and £16,400, the Warwick trailer sold to £14,400, the Mitsubishi Pick-up sold to £8,800. the CLAAS round baler sold to £7,400, the Marston bale trailer sold to £4,500, the CLAAS mower sold to £3,700 and the rake to £2,650, the Grass Harrows sold to £2,150 and the Ride On Lawnmower sold to £1400.

#### **HUNTINGDONSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL - NEW LOCAL PLAN**

Huntingdonshire District Council have agreed to start the preparation of a full update to their Adopted Local Plan which will set out how the District will grow over future decades. The Local Plan will set out a plan for future sustainable development in the District and it will perform two specific roles.

- Identify key areas of land for development to deliver homes, jobs and services needed in the District, and
- Include Policies against which all future planning applications will be considered.

Part of the review of the Local Plan will include a Call for Sites exercise which will run until Wednesday 7 June 2023. Landowners are being invited to submit sites with potential for:

- Residential use (such as housing, specialist homes, moorings, care homes etc.)
- Commercial use (such as retail, leisure, industrial, logistics etc.)
- Infrastructure (such as health uses, community facilities, renewable energy etc.)
- Open Space use (such as sports and recreation, allotments, biodiversity net gain, flooding safeguarding etc.)

For sites to be included in the Local Plan they must be capable of delivering five or more dwellings for residential sites, or 0.25 hectares (500 sq m) for commercial sites. We will be submitting sites on behalf of landowners to this process, along with supporting information and if you should have any land which you feel should be promoted through the Emerging Local Plan then please contact a member of the Planning and Development Team and we will be happy to assist you.

#### BEDFORD LIVESTOCK SHOW – MICHAELMAS 2023 DATE - SATURDAY 23 SEPTEMBER 2023

After the turmoil caused by Covid over the last few years and the very successful 2021 Bedford Christmas Show, followed by the cancellation of the Fatstock Dinner, to avoid holding a Covid "super spreader" event, the committee have met to consider their options for the future.

It has been decided that, rather than merging with the Thrapston and Northampton Christmas Fatstock Show, Bedford Show should retain a separate event, in order to retain our independence and identity. It is therefore proposed to hold a Bedford Show at Michaelmas, to be hosted in Thrapston Livestock Market on Saturday 23rd September 2023. It is proposed to move the focus away from prime finished stock, towards breeding and store stock and animals will be judged according to potential, as well as finish. Our main objective is to hold a successful Show and, whilst exhibitors will be able to offer their animals for sale on Show day, they will not be required to sell, in order to claim their prizes.

We will be sending out letters to potential sponsors, judges, etc, over the coming weeks but, if you are interested, we would ask you to speak to a member of the committee, in order that we can gauge the level of support. Entry fees and prize money will be set at the same level as the successful 2021 Christmas Show.

We hope that you will support this event, which will be open to all local farmers and, hopefully, will reflect the proud spirit of independence shared through the whole of the county of Bedfordshire.
