438 Prime Lambs

A strong case of a two tier trade again this week. Meated and best shape export lambs continue to see a flying trade, where as lean lambs are hard sold at the vendors disadvantage selling between 225p/kg and 270p/kg. SQQ 295.7p/kg. JLB Farming topped the day with a best end run of Texel lambs, seeing 329p/kg and £177.50 for 54kgs and their 56.5kgs to £167.

Highlights - T Sansom topped the lighter lambs with Beltex at 38kgs to £118.50 and £135 for 43kgs; Corney & Sons Ltd continue to draw smart Charollais crosses with 44.5kgs to £136 and 50kgs to £155; CW Webb & Partners topped their lambs with Charollais to £155 for 48kgs; WH Tanner & Son saw a best meat show of big framed Continental crosses selling to £172 for 56kgs with 57kgs to £170; C Stancombe & Son topped their meat Texel Mules to £151 for 47kgs.


FREE HEALTH ADVICE FOR FARMERS TO CONTINUE AT THRAPSTON MARKET




