183 Prime Lambs

Another clear example of quality lambs making the trade. Lambs need to be fed to reach premiums. K Welsby topped the day at 285p/kg or £122.55 for 43kg Texel and Charollais with their 40kgs selling to 282p/kg and 41kgs to 280p/kg. SQQ 257.47p/kg. MF Spencer topped the light lambs with thirty-eight Continental crosses to 258p/kg. J & M Ironmonger saw smart bred Texel lambs seeing 41.5kgs at 271p/kg. Leaner sorts sold at 250p/kg to 265p/kg.

Crowleys Farm topped the day with a smart pen of Texel crosses selling to £90 with followers at £84; T Young saw a high of £88 for Charollais, with smart frame smaller sorts selling to £80; M Gasson saw their Clun crosses of mid frames but lean fly to £87; Woolly Park Farm topped the Suffolks with big frame lean sorts seeing £81. Hampshire ram lambs saw £69.
