REPORT FOR TUESDAY 11TH JULY

518 Prime Lambs

A much bigger yarding this week, with some vendors over drawing on light and lean lambs as they start to grow frame with a flush of grass. Supply has caught up nationally this week causing the trade to come back to similar levels of two weeks ago. All lambs under 42kgs were hard sold. SQQ 266.32p/kg. P & M Careless topped the day with a sterling show of Charollais and Texel lambs at 44kgs selling to 285p/kg with 44.5kgs to 281p/kg and 46.5kgs to 279p/kg, topping overall at £129.74.

Highlights - JD Weaver saw smart Charollais at 42kgs to 280p/kg. AF & RF Slatter topped the Suffolks for the day with 46kgs selling to 274p/kg; WS Stanley saw a high of 279p/kg for 44kg Texels; with J Bourne & Sons selling a smart run of Charollais at 43kgs to 278p/kg.
