## REPORT FOR TUESDAY 17TH SEPTEMBER

### 345 Prime Lambs

Trade sharper this week with a better showing of meat lambs forward and trade nationally seeing a lift. SQQ 277.32p/kg. K Welsby penned a smart meat run of Texel lambs seeing their 40.5kgs top to 293p/kg with their heavy meat looking an even stronger trade at 290p/kg for 49.5kgs and 288p/kg for 50kgs; S Beale topped overall with a high of £189.53 for 66.5kg Suffolk ram lambs.

**Highlights** - GA Finlay topped the lighter lambs with Southdown crosses at good meat weighing 33.5kgs sold to 287p/kg; J & M Ironmonger saw a smart trade for Texels at 41kgs selling to 288p/kg; A Summers penned their usual goods seeing Lleyn cross Texels to 285p/kg for 41kgs; P & M Careless saw a smart show of best meat lambs selling to 282p/kg for 40.5kgs.
