Ellsbury Farm topped the day pence per kilo at 321p/kg for 36kgs with their 37.5kgs selling to 320p/kg. P & M Careless topped the day overall at £144.06 for smart best meat Charollais at 49kgs.

Highlights - NA Dawson saw similar highs with best end Texel crosses to 320p/kg for 36kg best meat lambs, with their 37.5kgs to 310p/kg; M Taylor topped with their Charollais at 37.5kgs to 316p/kg; L Beames saw a smart show of Charollais and Continental crosses forward with the best shape Charollais to 314p/kg for 40kg lambs; GJ Nichols topped the Suffolks in the heavier weights with 46kg to 294p/kg.
