322 Prime Lambs

Best spec lambs saw a flyer although under 40kgs were heavily penalised. Trade saw a bounce back with the SQQ at 289.37p/kg. P & M Careless topped the day with tremendous Charollais selling two pens at 297.5p/kg for 45kg and 44.5kgs. John Bourne & Son topped the day overall with heavy 58kg Continentals at 240p/kg or £139.20.

Highlights - RS Hawkins topped their run of Texels with 42kgs selling to 296p/kg; R Rainbow & Sons drew a fantastic run of Beltex crosses at 43kgs selling to 295p/kg with their heavier lambs at 49kgs topping to 270p/kg; A Phillips saw the best of the Suffolks with well meated 44kgs at 295p/kg; WR Spencer saw their first draw reap rewards with Charollais crosses to 43.5kgs making 293.50p/kg.

Lean ewes were seen in the £80's with true long term feeders at £40.

Plants, Produce, Hatching Eggs & Sundries

Plants & Shrubs - Less bedding plants forward this week, but a few more shrubs and hanging baskets which sold to £8 from £6, Roses sold to £7.50 from £6, Pelargonium's sold to £5, a Stone Rabbit sold to £5 and Sunflowers sold to £5.

Produce - A great selection of feed forward, Dog Food sold to £11, Layers Pellets sold to £10 from £8, Wild Bird Feed sold to £10, Pigeon Feed sold to £9, Growers Pellets sold to £8 along with Mixed Corn, Chick Crumbs, Rabbit Nuggets and Duck Food. Bags of Broad Beans hand-picked that morning sold to £1.80 from £1.50.

Hatching Eggs - Trays of Hen eggs sold to £5, two dozen Hen eggs sold to £4.50, 15 Pheasant eggs sold to £3, ½ dozen Duck eggs sold to £1.20 and Goose eggs sold to £1 each.

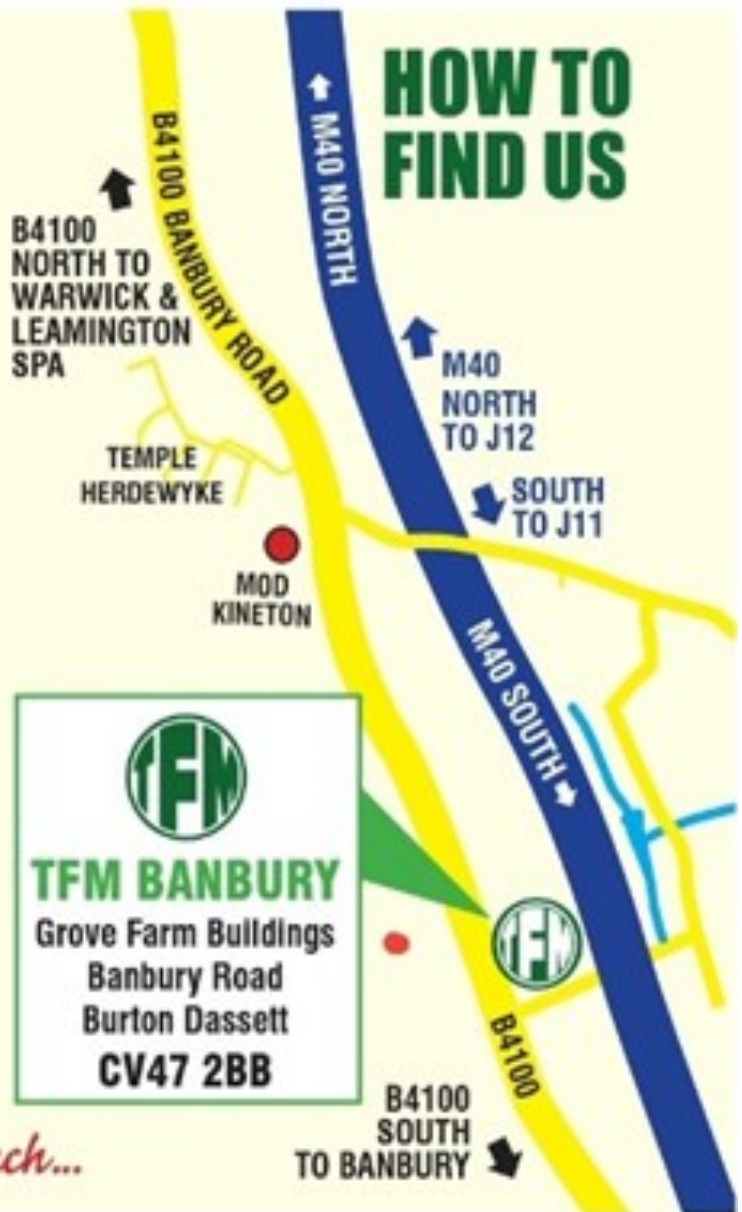
