#### **REPORT FOR THURSDAY 8TH AUGUST**

#### 608 Prime Lambs

A strong number forward this week with many looking to have drawn lambs at weaning. This was the finest example of a two tier trade, seeing well meated lambs on a flying trade, with lean under finished lambs penalised hard. Lean/Store lambs are far better sold on a Saturday at the store sale to active store buying accounts.

SQQ 296.77p/kg. WF Knight & Son penned another quality draw of Charollais and Texel cross Continentals seeing a high of 355p/kg for best meat at 44kgs, with their 45.5kgs selling to £156 and £150, 50.5kgs to £169 and 49kgs to £160; Cambridge University Farm topped the day overall with best meat Suffolks to £170 for 60kgs.

**Highlights** - S Clark topped the lighter lambs with Texels at 39kgs to £124; MR Peters & Son saw a flying trade for their Blue Texels with 45kgs selling to £151 and 50kgs of the same stamp to £160; I Birden penned a best end run of Dutch Spotted lambs seeing highs of £144 for 45kgs; W Veal penned a smart run of Texels seeing the best at 48kgs topping to £159.50; J Gowling & Sons continued their run of best meat Charollais and Texels crosses seeing highs of £159 for 49kgs, £158 for 48.5kgs and 47kgs to £153.

R Swinfen & Sons penned a tremendous run of Texel and Continental ewes seeing best shape and size to £199, £193.50, £174 and £169; CP Hankins & Son topped with a Cheviot cross ewe of top end weight at £174; IW Parrot topped the Suffolks on the day selling to £167 and £165. Good meat, heavy ewes were all seen over £140. R Swinfen & Sons topped the Mules for the day at £129. Lean meat big ewes were seen around £125. Grazers were harder sold again this week looking between £65 and £80.

#### **NFU SURVEY**

NFU are currently conducting a **<u>survey about tail docking and castration in</u> <u>lambs</u> to help inform discussions with the government on potential new restrictions.** 

We kindly ask that you complete the survey, and share the survey with your customers, to gather vital information on the impact of any proposed restrictions to the current practises of tail docking and castration within both farming businesses and the lamb market.

Please see full details and the survey link below.

Tail docking and castration in lambs is considered necessary to manage negative health and welfare impacts caused by fly-strike, or to avoid unwanted pregnancies and complications during post-slaughter processing.

Both procedures are permitted in the UK and governed by legislation however, the <u>Farm Animal Welfare Council's report</u> released in December 2022 discussed the implications of castration and tail docking (which are in the legal terms described as mutilation procedures) on the welfare of lambs and makes several recommendations related to these routine management procedures.

As a result of this report and due to growing pressure on the veterinary profession and resource, there is potential for regulatory changes to be taken forward by the new government.

The NFU is therefore seeking sheep producers' participation in a short survey on the lamb production and husbandry and management methods. (Open to both members and non-members)

This will provide us with a comprehensive understanding of practices within the sector and the necessary information and data to highlight the detrimental impact of introducing restrictions on these routine management procedures.

#### **REPORT FOR SATURDAY 10TH AUGUST**

#### 475 Store & Breeding Sheep

**Store Lambs** - no let up in the trade this week with some early vendors now getting through their lambs. A larger entry of longer term lambs on the day, averaging £90.40. R Spencer topped the day with a fantastic showing of Texel lambs selling to £136.50 for Ram lambs and followers to £127; C Thompson penned another strong run of Suffolks seeing £126 for their top and £104 for followers; RJ Garley had another quality run of Texel crosses forward with a high of £125 for the biggest framed lambs through to £108, £100 and £98; CL Fraser & Son penned a real smart run of Continental lambs seeing mid frame tight skins sell to £120, £115, £114 and £102; PT Harris & Son sold another draw of Hampshire crosses of strong frame but long term to £108.50. All Continental smart shape lambs were £98 plus with well bred healthy mid to long term lambs £84 to £95. Long term lambs were £75 plus.

**Feeding Ewes** - trade continues to hold on the back of the cull trade averaging  $\pounds$ 71.30. JA & MJ Kitchener topped the day with Suffolks to  $\pounds$ 131.50 and  $\pounds$ 105 for lean meat; A Chaffe saw the trade of the day with Herdwick ewes to  $\pounds$ 100. Mid frame lean ewes were around £85 with C Haste having a flying trade for Welsh ewes to £55.

#### Pigs

N Gabriel penned a smart show of Landrace crosses, seeing store gilts to £44, with their gilt weaners to £30 and boars to £20.

#### Calves

Chellington Partners drew a smart well done run of TB4 calves, seeing their British Blue heifers to £290 and Hereford heifers to £275 and £265, their bull calves sold to £255 for Herefords and £100 for Holstein Friesians; FH Pullin & Sons saw another smart entry of TB1 Holsteins Friesians at a month old to £60.


