### REPORT FOR TUESDAY 26TH SEPTEMBER

#### 532 Prime Lambs

A bigger entry forward than predicted with a good showing of meat and weight although with lean lambs in the mix. Meat and weight continue to hit premiums with 45kgs sought after. SQQ 243.18p/kg. Newfield Horses Ltd topped the day pence per kilo with their usual goods, seeing best end Texels to 256p/kg for 42kgs with their 48.5kgs at 254p/kg, coming to a total of £123.19. R Hall & Sons topped the day with Suffolks to £123.75 for 55kgs.

**Highlights** - P & M Careless drew a smart showing of Charollais with the top end of 47.5kgs to 249p/kg and 53kgs to 230p/kg; WS Gabb penned a big framed run of Continentals with a high of 227p/kg for 52.5kgs, with 47.5kgs of the same stamp to 245p/kg; A Summers saw a smart showing of Texels at 46kgs flying to 248p/kg. D & D Shortt penned the same stamp of Texels at 47kgs selling to 247.5p/kg.

### 123 Store & Breeding Sheep

**Breeding Sheep** - P & M Miller kicked off the stores with a well grown stretchy run of MV Texel rams selling to £200; TC Williams & Sons had a smart entry of Wiltshire Horn shearling rams forward topping at £160, to go alongside their full and broken mouth Welsh Mules topping at £90; A Berks saw the trade of the day with North Country Mule theaves, run dry selling to £180 and taking the two pens with the option.

**Store Lambs** - A lot more life in the job this week with a better framed run of lambs and buying power to match. All in average saw £65.52. IH & D Woodfin topped the run with Romney crosses to £87; JD Hatton saw a compact run of Texel crosses with potential sell to £78.50 and £71; NA Lilley saw their usual stamp of Charollais forward with a high of £70; R Peach sold a run of Texel cross ram lambs with the first pen at £66 and followers to £50.

### 208 Cull Ewes & Rams

Another tremendous trade at Stratford. More numbers once again than expected, following the national slump, but buying power was not a problem. All in average £80.12. N & LC Holdsworth topped the day with Texel rams of tremendous power selling to £139; WJ Barnett & Son saw best end Charollais ewes to £124; J & M Ironmonger penned their usual stamp of Texels with the weight being paid for at £112; JD Hatton topped their run of Continentals to £110 for several lots with followers to £106; MR & BE Baylis saw the trade of the day with big framed meat Mule ewes to £103, only to be outsold by their second pen at £88 including proper feeders; H Jackson topped the Suffolks for the day with long meat ewes at £101. Weight continues to be paid for, with lean meat also in demand. The vast majority forward saw in excess of £85 with feeding ewes close to £80.


