A better week than expected with trade looking to have dropped hard all week. Best lambs continue to see premiums with only lambs of all finish wanted over 42kgs, anything under very hard sold. SQQ 259.5p/kg. NK Butcher topped the day with a sterling run of Texels at 271.5p/kg. RE Greenhill topped the day overall with Charollais Mules to £135.42 for 55.5kgs.

Highlights - Newfield Horses Ltd penned a fantastic run of Texels with the smartest at 43kgs reaching 270p/kg, with the heavier 45kgs at 268p/kg; P & M Careless topped their run with best finished Texel at 269p/kg for 45kgs, with their 47kgs lambs of the same stamp selling to 268.5p/kg; N Wyatt topped the Suffolks on the day with thick 48kgs selling to 260p/kg; AF & RF Slatter saw similar highs with 47.5kgs to 259p/kg.
