Numbers and quality draw the trade with a majority sterling show forward. DO Threadgold topped with tremendous Texels at 41.5kgs selling to 354p/kg. Ulmus Farm Ltd topped the day overall with 73kg Texels at £170. SQQ 311.78p/kg.

Highlights - LA Burton topped the lighter lambs with Texels to 39kgs selling at £128; Cartwright Farms topped the Charollais with fantastic shape 42.5kgs at £142; WF Knight & Son saw the same highs with their best finished 44kg Texels at £142; Ulmus Farm Ltd saw more highs with their 47.5kg texels to £150; RA Bounds saw best finished Suffolk crosses to £148 for 52kgs.

NOTICE

Applications for animal health and welfare equipment and technology grants will close at midday on the 15th of June 2023.

Grants of between £1,000 and £25,000 towards the cost of items that improve the health and welfare of livestock are currently available through the Farming Equipment and Technology Fund, as part of the Animal Health and Welfare Pathway.

The grant is open to all farmers or contractors with a business in England who keep:

- beef and dairy cattle,
- sheep,
- pigs,
- laying hens and broilers (including rearing and breeding farms)

You do not need to be eligible for BPS to apply.

Each application must be for a minimum grant of £1000. To meet this, you can apply for multiple items as part of your application.

For example, a cattle farmer could bundle together a head scoop for a cattle crush, a calving gate and an EID panel reader in their application, to cross the minimum grant threshold.

All applications for this round must be submitted by **midday on the 15th of June**, so if you're interested, you should act now.

Store & Breeding Cattle

Cows & Calves - Sold to £2300 for a Limousin cow with a Limousin heifer calf at foot from J Bottesch; others sold to £990 for a Limousin cow with a 7 month Limousin heifer calf at foot from J & D Bavington, who also entered an empty Dairy bred Limousin cow that sold to £800.

Store Cattle - TG Williams sold his 19 month Limousin heifers to £1400 and steers to £1300, to average £1215; J Pell sold 9-11 month Angus steers to £740, heifers to £610, to average £650; J Bottesch sold two 23 month Limousin heifers to £1690 from £1680.
