### 255 Prime Lambs

Prices similar on the week with heavier lambs once again in demand, over 45kgs saw the best overall prices, leaner lambs can be sold but 20p/kg below comparables. SQQ 245.11p/kg. A Paxton topped the day overall with best meat Texel lambs to 250p/kg for 46kgs; Baylis Farming topped overall with 53kg Texel Mules to £127.20.

**Highlights** - S Keyte & Sons saw their first draw of Texel Lleyns forward with 45.5kgs topping to 249p/kg and their 44.5kgs to 248p/kg; WE Budd & Son saw the same highs with a strong showing of Charollais at 45.5kgs also selling to 249p/kg; R & EM Prentice topped their draw of bigger frame lambs at 247.5p/kg for both 45kg and 47.5kg Texel crosses; T Hyatt saw a best meat run of shorn Charollais crosses with the 46.5kgs selling to 247p/kg and 53kgs to 238p/kg.

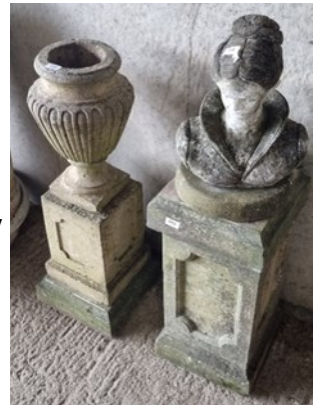

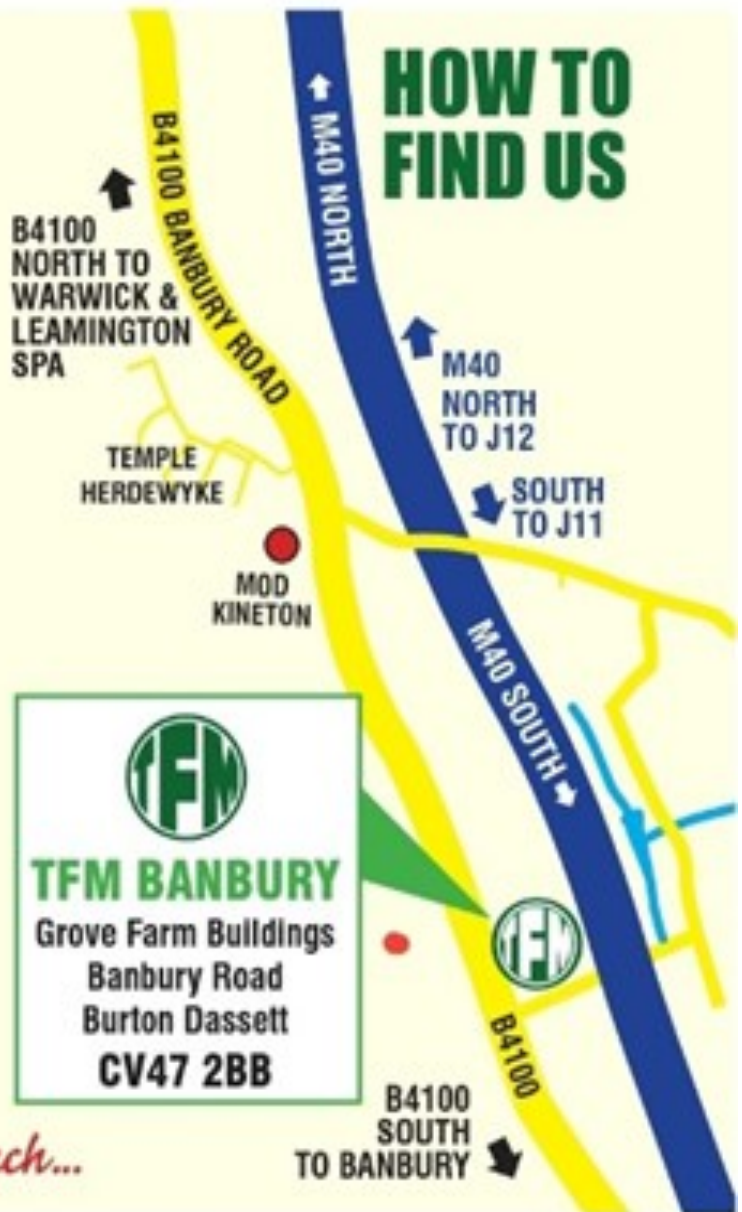
