MJ Gillet & Partners topped the day pence per kilo at 275p/kg for smart best shape lighter weight Texels. C Wynn topped the day overall at £156 for cross bred heavies at 65kgs, with their 57kgs to 230p/kg.

Highlights - RS Hawkins topped with a smart run of Texel and Charollais to 269p/kg for 43kgs and 266p/kg for 51kgs of the same stamp; J & M Ironmonger saw their usual run of quality with Texel lambs at 44kgs selling to 265p/kg; C Clews penned a best finished show of Texels at 48kgs to 260p/kg.
