Ellsbury House topped the lighter lambs with 37kg best end Texels to 279p/kg; A & M Turney saw highs of 275p/kg for 43kgs; MJ Gillet & Partners topped the heavier lambs with Charollais at 47kgs and 46kgs selling to 265p/kg.
