#### REPORT FOR THURSDAY 7TH NOVEMBER

#### 555 Prime Lambs

A good show of meated lambs with the trade holding well and SQQ 276.177p/kg. WG Child & Sons topped the day pence per kilo at 304p/kg for good smart meat Texel crosses at 40kgs. PM Bonner topped overall at £167 for 63.5kg Texels.

**Highlights** - C Stancombe & Son saw a best end meat showing of Texel Mules with 44kgs selling to £128; GI Rogers penned a best meat show of Charollais crosses seeing highs of £150 for 52kgs and 51kgs to £145 for several pens; Corney & Sons penned their usual stamp of Texel and Charollais crosses with meat lambs at 51kgs to £148; PM Bonner topped their Texels to £167 for 63.5kgs with 54.5kgs to £155; W Veal saw a smart show of Texels at 62kgs selling to £160.

SH & RS Whinney topped the day at £195 for Suffolk rams; W Hammond saw similar highs with Beltex rams to £180 with followers at £160; Corney & Sons saw smart Continental ewes to £145; SJB Luckett & Son topped with meat Continental ewes at £144; KS Lee saw the best of the Suffolk trade with ewes to £130 and Mules to £102. All meat was over £95 with lean meat types £70 to £85. True feeders are sub £50.

### Budget 2024 – Schemes and Spending

DEFRA have secured a budget of £2.4 billion for the next financial year which means momentum can be maintained on Environmental Land Management (ELM) schemes going forward.

The Sustainable Farming Incentive remains open and more detail will be published on Countryside Stewardship Higher Tier in December, which will have a rolling application window and a 'streamline application process'. An additional £208 million has been allocated for 2024–2026 to upgrade to the Animal and Plant Health Agency's biosecurity facilities at Weybridge, and an extra £400 million, over the next two years, for Peatland Restoration and Woodland Creation. Further reductions were announced to the Delinked Payments for 2025. A 76% reduction from the base value is to apply to the first £30,000, with no payment to come on any value above that.

With the maximum payment to be made in 2025 to be £7,200, there is no indication of what, if anything, might be paid in 2026 or 2027, originally intended to be the last year of payment.

**Store Cattle** - TN Thomson sold a bunch of six Aberdeen Angus 7-13 month steers to £920; C & A Morley sold 7-8 month Charolais steers to £1220 and 8 month Limousin steers to £1030; Eastern Farms Ltd sold six Charolais 17 month steers to £1670; C Davies sold Highland x 7 month heifers to £390; Padray Farms sold Limousin steers to £1240 from £1210; AJ Day & Son sold Limousin steers to £2080 from £1500 to average £1747.

#### **Calves**

Sold to £220 for a British Blue heifer and an Angus heifer and Blue bulls sold to £205, all from Sunbeam Farms; Chellington Partners sold a Blue bull and heifer both selling to £190.

#### **Pigs**

Sold to £120 from Mini One Plant Hire; Gilts sold to £100 from Mrs T Bately and her weaned pigs sold to £45 and £40.

**Store Lambs** - an unbelievable trade this week seeing a massive lift with an all in average £93.94! All lambs look very well sold but the longer term were off the clock. A Chaffe topped with smart Texel lambs to £124 in forward condition; PD & PA Roff saw a serious trade for Charollais cross cade lambs at £123; J Grace saw highs of £111 for smart bred, good shape mid frame Texel lambs with followers at £107 and £80; NP & MJ Russell topped with their smallest but best shape lambs at £110 with bigger framed plainer sorts at £108 and £104; J Pringle topped to £110 for smart Texels of mid frame with their smaller end at £95; JA & MJ Kitchener tipped the Suffolks to £100, with their Texel crosses at the same mark; GJ Nichols saw a small frame run of Texel Mule lambs forward with the biggest eighteen at £93 with followers at £88 and £71; G Exton saw their Charollais crosses to £77, £76 and £70. The only lambs sold on the day below £70 were rams lambs at £59.

**Feeding Ewes** - another sterling trade following the cull market, averaging £59.39. PT Harris & Son topped to £103 for Texel crosses with Suffolks to £90; D Jerrams topped their run at £100 for Charollais crosses with Texel crosses to £85, their Mules saw a high of £85. Very leanest Mules sold to £67 (a flying trade).
