REPORT FOR THURSDAY 24TH AUGUST

517 Prime Lambs

A national shortage has forced a lift in trade. Once again another majority showing of quality well finished lambs. Weight continues to find top prices. SQQ 263.18p/kg. Best end export quality saw a flyer with MR Peters & Son topping to 297p/kg for 50.5kg Blue Texels at £150 which topped the day overall with more Beltex types from the same home at 40kgs selling to 293p/kg.

Highlights - SJ Hubbard penned another best end showing of Texels with 45.5kgs selling to £129, only to be outdone by their heavier lambs at 52kgs selling to £145 and £142; JLB Farming saw a quality run forward with Texel lambs at 48kgs flying to £133 and 55.5kgs to £140; DO Threadgold penned their usual best end lambs with best meat 54.5kg Texels at £144; WF Knight & Son continued the day with their Charollais and Texel lambs topping to £127.50 for 44.5kgs with 44kgs at the same price and two more pens to £125.

REPORT FOR SATURDAY 26TH AUGUST

Store & Breeding Cattle

Cows & Calves sold to £1960 for a Limousin cow with a Limousin heifer calf at foot with others selling from £1540 to average £1720, entered for a Dispersal Sale from David Self. Heifers sold to £1530 for an 18 month Limousin from C Hopperton who entered others at £1490, £1390 and £1200; JA & P Dickinson sold a 32 month Aberdeen Angus heifer to £1465; C Horrell sold two Shorthorn heifers 14 & 17 months to £1095; RJ Clark entered 24 month Aberdeen Angus heifers which sold to £870 and £760; AC Downing sold a 22 month Angus heifer to £760 and a steer to £905. Steers topped at £1110 for a pair of 27 month Limousins.

Calves

Another good trade was seen for calves, topping at £370 for a British Blue bull calf, a similar calf made £350 and an Aberdeen Angus bull sold to £250 all from JEG James. A good entry on 2nd September, if you need calves.

374 Store & Breeding Sheep

Store lambs - a strong sale on the week with lambs easing as the Breeding Sales are in flow. All in average saw £79.23. LA Burton topped the day with their usual stamp of Texel lambs topping to £108, with the smaller frame same stamp of lambs selling to £93.50 and £91.50; J Grace continued with a smart showing of Texels with compact frame but forward condition, topping to £97 with followers at £79; GK Doyle penned a run of cream with Beltex selling to £97 and Cheviots to £85; NP & MJ Russell saw a smart entry of Texel Mules in forward condition selling to £96.50 and £89 for Texels; FW Smith & Son topped the Suffolks for the day seeing well grown lambs to £88; ATC Lepper & Son had another run of Charollais crosses forward of a similar stamp to previous weeks at £88, £82 and £77. Longest term lambs look the dearest with the smallest frame lambs selling at £55 plus.

Feeding ewes - a tremendous trade for the ewes on show with bright lean ewes looking the best sold. All in average £80.29. R Daubney topped the day with Texel cross ewes to £142 with leaner types of the same style to £108; M Holben topped their run with small frame smart Beltex ewes to £117, only to be out done by his Mules at £100; A Chaffe saw a high of £108 for Texel rams; JA & P Dickinson topped the native breeds with Herdwick ewes to £100.50; David Jerrams saw the trade of the day with old Continental type ewes to £70.50. Nothing sold on the day below £50.

Tack, Saddlery & Equine

Prices amazed many in the equine ring with prices seen to a top of £650 for a Shetland, a Coloured cob sold to £530, a 2 year old Filly sold to £520, a Yearling spotted colt sold to £500 and Coloured colts sold to £280 from £220 and a 11hh coloured aged Stallion sold to £180.




