REPORT FOR THURSDAY 24TH OCTOBER

633 Prime Lambs

Trade and numbers are unaffected this week at Thrapston with extra buyers in the alleys. A great showing of heavy meated lambs forward with the overall average at 276.37p/kg and the SQQ at 274.60p/kg. Best meat 43kg-47kg lambs are in demand seeing a shortage. All lambs must be best meat to see the trade. Lean light lambs are sold at store prices. Raveley Fen Farms topped the day pence per kilo at 329p/kg for Charollais Beltex lambs at 49kgs; Hyde Lane Farms topped the day overall at £175 with Texel crosses at 62kgs.

Highlights - M Turner topped the lighter lambs with Continentals to £129 for 42kgs with heavier lambs of the same stamp at £158 for 50kgs; Grange Farm saw their well fed Texels to £130 for 45.5kgs; Park End Farming Ltd saw their smartest Texels to £150 for both 47kg and 49kgs; Hyde Lane Farms topped their show of smartest Beltex crosses to £175 for 62kgs with Texel crosses to £165 at 51.5kgs; Raveley Fen Farms continue their best end showing of Charollais crosses seeing 49kgs to £161 and 63.5kgs to £175 and handy weights at 59kgs to £170.
