A harder days trading with a majority showing of lean lambs. DM & A Andrews topped the day pence per kilo with smart Texels at 45kgs selling to 292p/kg; Crimscote Downs topped the day overall at £144.94 for 50.5kg Texels. P & M Careless saw smart Texels to 290p/kg for 44kgs; J & M Ironmonger saw their Texels to 288p/kg for 45kgs. Best end meat lambs were seen in the £80's with lean meat in the £70's. REPORT FOR WEDNESDAY 11TH SEPTEMBER

Another fantastic annual Breeding Sale at Stratford market with 1348 breeding sheep forward on the day. Trade far exceeded expectations with more buying power on the day than seen before.

Store Lambs - additional late entries boosted the sale with a fantastic average of £79.55. All grades of lambs were in strong demand, seeing John Bourne & Son topping the day with forward condition Charollais ram lambs at £110 followed by big framed clean lambs at £98; AV Taylor topped the Suffolks for the day at £92 for strong big framed lambs; S Carlton penned a smart run of Suffolks seeing them top to £90 with Texel Mules to £89; Townsend Farms saw their Charollais lambs to £88. Good going on mid frame lambs were seen in the £80's. Longer term lambs were £50 to £65.

Ewe Lambs - AR & PR Whitmill saw the trade of the day for Suffolk Mule lambs topping at £137 for big frame, smart clean headed lambs selling to £137 and £110; Lambs End Ltd topped their Texel lambs to £132 for best shape smart sorts with their Texel and Suffolk crosses selling to £104.

Theaves - another unbelievable trade this year with a whole sale average in the theaves coming to £200.46. North Country Mules - another flying year for the Mule theaves at Stratford with an all in average of £215.35. A Cook topped the day with a smart run of lambed theaves seeing highs of £240 for three pens with the final at £235, their ran dry Mules saw the same highs selling to £235, £220 thrice and £210; J Albutt saw a tremendous run with big framed smart headed theaves selling to £230, £215 and £210; GA Royans & Son saw the same highs for the same style of goods selling to £230, £228 and £220; D Blunn saw a smart pen of deep bodied Welsh Mule theaves stand out from the crowd and top at £230. Continentals - DM Harris penned her usual stamp of Bleu de Maine theaves with serious power selling to £240; D & S Hutsby saw their Texel Mule theaves reach high demand and sell to £192, the same home saw Blue Texels to £150. Suffolks - a smart trade for the powerful theaves with R Rainbow & Sons topping the day at £220 for two pens; RV Woodward saw £180, with G Hookham and CW Cowper & Sons all selling to £170.
