Location and Directions to the Sale

Main Road Farm is situated on the A4500 road in Earls Barton, Northamptonshire.

- From Northampton take Junction 10 off the main A45 follow this road for 2 miles to the next set of traffic lights, turn right on to the A4500 the farm is $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from this junction on the left.

- From the A14 passing Little Irchester on the A45 turn after junction 14, at the Wilby Way roundabout, follow the A509 signed Kettering and Wilby A509. Take the left turn at the next roundabout signed Wilby, from here travel $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles on the A4500 and the farm is on the right. Junction 11 can also be used on the A45, this is sign posted Earls Barton, from this junction travel on the B573 into Earls Barton, then turn right on to Northampton Road signed Mears Ashby, at the next traffic lights turn right the farm is $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from this junction on the left.














CONDITIONS OF SALE

- 5. Neither the vendors nor the Auctioneers make any warranty regarding engine hours or vehicle mileages.
- 6. All descriptions, either written or verbal, are for guidance purposes only. The Auctioneers or Vendors will not be responsible for the accuracy of any such description. All lots are sold with all faults and errors of description. Purchasers must satisfy themselves prior to the sale of a lot, as to the condition of each lot and should exercise and rely on their own judgement as to whether the lot accords with its description.
